Police telephone numbers:

EMERGENCY: 9-1-1

Non-Emergency: 412-279-6911 (Allegheny County Dispatch) this is the **main** number used to contact the Collier Township Police. When you call this number and specify that you need Collier Township Police, they will contact the on-duty Officers and send them to the correct Collier Township location or advise them of your call.

OFFICE: 412-276-5051 This number is for leaving a message for a specific Officer in their voicemail. This will be listened to when the Officer is on duty next. This number may also be used for general questions only. **Police are not dispatched from this number.**

ACCIDENT REPORTS: Accident reports are \$15.00. Reportable accidents are when someone is injured, or a vehicle needs to be towed. They are only released to insurance companies and people involved in the accident. **Please call first to make sure your report is finished.** Reports can be requested Monday-Friday 8:00AM to 3:30PM. Reports can be mailed after receiving a request with a \$15.00 check and a self-addressed, stamped envelope or fax number.

ALARMS: Any resident or business with an alarm system needs a permit. Resident alarms cost \$50.00. Business alarms cost \$65.00. This is a one-time fee. You can have three (3) free false alarms in a calendar year and after that, there is a fee starting at \$50.00 each. There are copies of this form on the website or in the building.

ANIMAL REGISTRATION: Please contact the Allegheny County Treasurer's Office at 412-350-4100. A dog license can be obtained through their website at www.alleghenycounty.us/treasurer/dog.aspx

EMERGENCY CONTACTS: This provides the Officers an emergency contact for after business hours. There are copies of this form on the website or in the building.

SOLICITATION: Anyone who goes door to door to advertise their business or products, even by placing a flyer, is a solicitor. The exceptions are religious groups and political parties. All others need a permit. There are rules as to when and where they are permitted. **Solicitors will receive a list of residential areas they are not permitted to be solicited in.** You can contact the Police Department at 412-276-5051 to be added to the "no solicitation list". If someone comes to your door, they need a permit and their ID. **When in doubt call 412-279-6911.**

VACATION NOTIFICATION FORM: This provides Officers with an emergency contact if you are going to be away from your home for an extended period of time. There are copies of this form on the website or in the building.
