## Recycling & Waste Collection Guidelines

Follow these simple steps to ensure your recycling and waste are collected quickly and easily.

- All recycling and waste must be placed at the curb no later than 6 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. Late set-out will be noted and may not be picked up.
- Waste should be in bags weighing no more than 35 pounds. Personal containers are optional.
- Hedge cuttings, limbs and branches should be securely tied and should not exceed 48 inches in length. Branches should not exceed 3 inches in diameter. Christmas trees will be picked up curbside in December, January and February.
- Bulk items will be accepted at curbside (limit 1 item per month). Special collection is available for more than 1 item per month for a fee. Please call customer service at **800-464-2120**.
- Carpet should be rolled and tied in lengths not to exceed 48 inches.
- Empty paint cans and/or dried paint is acceptable. Paint can be dried by air drying or soaking up with newspaper or kitty litter. Lids should be left off.
- Items such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers or any other appliance containing refrigerant will only be picked up if the item has a sticker certifying the refrigerant has been removed. If there is no sticker certifying removal, we will not pick up the items due to laws prohibiting disposal without certification the refrigerant has been removed. It is suggested that you have the company delivering the new appliance dispose of the old appliance to save on the removal cost of the refrigerant.
- Remove recycling and waste carts from the curb within 24 hours of collection.
- Leaves are picked up by the municipality.

## Unacceptable Materials

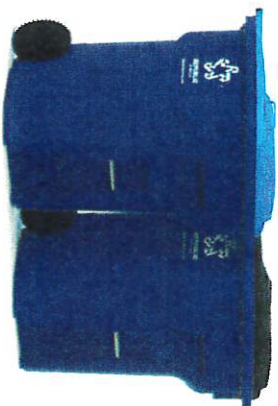
- ✗ Glass bottles or jars\*
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Yard waste
- ✗ Ceramics or dishes
- ✗ Plastic grocery bags
- ✗ Motor oil containers
- ✗ Electronics
- ✗ Plastics #3-#7
- ✗ Clothing
- ✗ Polystyrene foam
- ✗ Light bulbs
- ✗ Window glass or mirrors
- ✗ Construction waste
- ✗ Hazardous waste containers

\*While glass is not accepted, there will be a container available at the municipal building for glass bottles and jars only (no windows, mirrors, glass or dishes). Please be sure glass items are empty, clean and dry. Only put glass in this container, as other materials such as plastic and cardboard will contaminate the load.
