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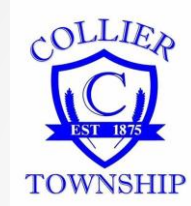

Milestones from 2013 Plan

- ❖ Zoning Ordinance Update in 2015 & Zoning Ordinance Amendment in 2021.
 - ❖ Signage has been added to gateways throughout the Township.
 - ❖ Connectivity Standards have been established to encourage safe and effective connections for all modes of transportation.
 - ❖ A solar roof was installed on the Public Works building.
 - ❖ Recycling events are held regularly to increase local recycling participation.
 - ❖ Email Blast has been established to enhance Township communication.
 - ❖ Township's website is utilized to engage residents in planning efforts.
 - ❖ Township's Park and Recreation hold events to reach out to Collier residents and businesses to build support for projects within the Township.
 - ❖ Township Engineer and Public Works regularly evaluate Township road construction and maintenance.
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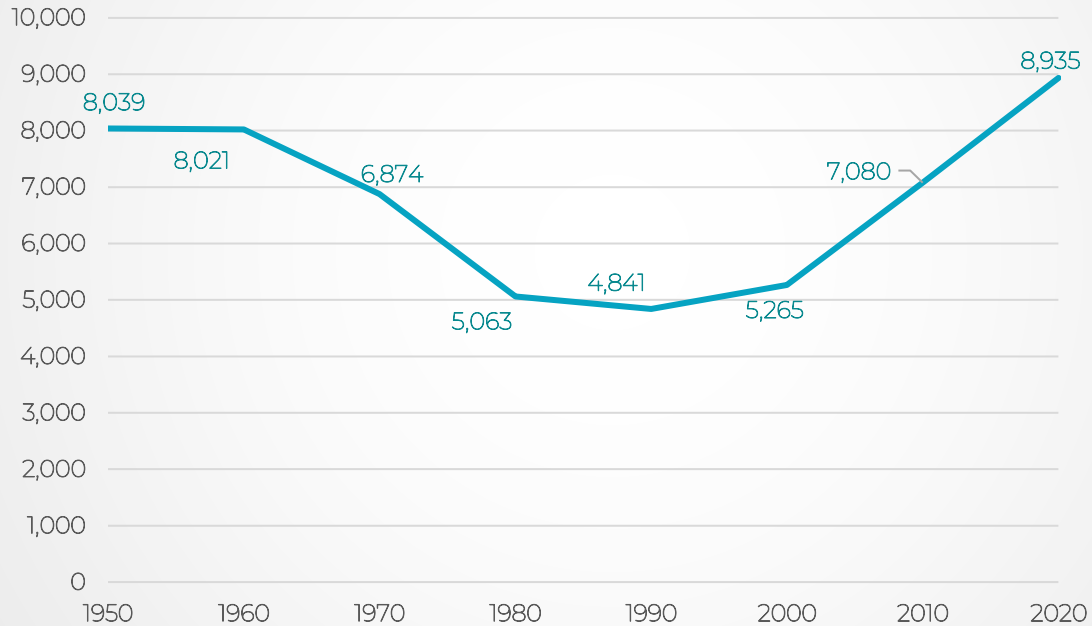

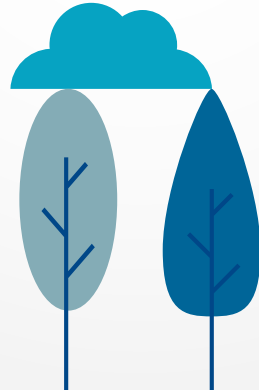
