- D. Approval of Minutes – May 20, 2024
- E. Public Comments – None
- F. Reports
  - 1. Treasurer’s Report – Balance as of 4/30/24 is \$28,046.27.
    - a. This amount was deposited into our new bank = First National Bank
    - b. Debbie and Mary Ann were issued debit cards.
    - c. We now have 4 signers for checks, Mary Ann, Susan, Deb, and Stephanie
  - 2. Park’s Report
    - a) Davis/Davis started camera installation at Webb Park, still waiting on Comcast to install internet to set up license plate reader.
    - b) Friends of Collier agreed to sponsor the camera system at Webb Park
    - c) Fixed and replaced safety lights with LED at Webb Park
    - d) Mill climber was delivered and set up by G&G Fitness
    - e) There are 540 signed up for the Basketball League this summer. \$70 for members, \$90 for nonmembers.
    - f) Replaced Tennis Nets at Collier Park
    - g) Sportscape quoted \$8100 to resurface basketball courts at Webb Park
    - h) Received \$5000 sponsorship from Smoke Cigar Shop and Pittsburgh Bottleshop for Concerts in the Park
    - i) Working on vendors and food trucks for Community Days
    - j) Letters were mailed to local businesses and organizations for Community Days
    - k) Travis updated the field project with 3 new price options.
    - l) Summer basketball registrations are open and have over 250 kids registered.
    - m) Basketball camp scheduled for June 24-27<sup>th</sup>.
    - n) New Assisted Stretch – one on one session with fitness instructor Erika

- o) Volleyball clinics May 22 and June 3
- p) Chess Summer Camps June 24-28<sup>th</sup> and August 5-9<sup>th</sup>, 15 kids registered, and registration is still open.
- q) CV Softball is finished playing games at Webb.
- r) CJ2K Summer Basketball League is starting June 2
- s) Hiring 11 kids for Summer Camp starting June 3<sup>rd</sup> at \$11/hour
- t) Games for Collier Community Day – Charge will be \$5 per child. This will permit each child to play all games for a flat fee.
