Effective as of February 16th, 2026, Sergeant Kris Sabin has been promoted to the position of new Police Chief of the Collier Township Police Department.

Police Chief Kris Sabin was raised in Ingram and graduated from Montour High School in 1991. He is an Eagle Scout and previously served as State Master Councilor for the Order of DeMolay. Chief Sabin earned a Bachelor of Arts in Administration of Criminal Justice from the University of Pittsburgh in 1996 and graduated from the Allegheny County Police Training Academy later that year.

Chief Sabin began his public safety career as a dispatcher with the Robinson Township Police Department before serving as a police officer with the Oakdale Borough Police Department. Since joining the Collier Township Police Department in 1998, he has served in numerous training and leadership roles, including Firearms, Defensive Tactics, and Taser Instructor. He has also provided guidance as a Field Training Officer and program coordinator. He was promoted to Sergeant in 2019 and named Acting Chief in 2025.

Chief Sabin has served on the executive board of the Collier Township Police Association, developing a strong working knowledge of labor and union matters. For the past 14 years, he has served as Co-Chairman of the Association's Community Outreach Fund, fostering meaningful partnerships with local businesses and residents. Committed to professional growth, Chief Sabin completed the FBI-LEEDA Supervisor Leadership Institute, Command Leadership Institute, and Executive Leadership Institute, earning the Trilogy Award. Chief Sabin brings to his role a strong commitment to community engagement, accessibility, and public trust.
